

## 2020DOC and Install

2020DOC (DOC) is a desktop application that enables the creation, editing, storage and retrieval of electronic documents in the eDOC system. It supports high-volume scanning and automated import from CSV-indexed files. It has extensive editing capabilities for both images and index data. 2020DOC is used in conjunction with ProDOC Forms or ProDOC Receipts to capture documents and store them with electronic signatures.

## PRODUCT UPDATES

- Modified to set default PDFViewer to 2.
- Fixed an "Index out of bounds" error when logging in a user that has no permissions.
- Hid the "Upgrade Database" checkbox when selecting a control ID after login.
  - All database upgrades should be done using MySQL Configurator.
- Fixed a bug where if the user selected a user to review and then immediately clicked the "new" button to create a new user and give them privileges, those privileges were being updated in the previously selected/reviewed user.
- Fixed the database version check to do a numeric instead of string-based comparison.
- Added an option to allow "minimum" database versions other than the version in the current SQL
  Data Module unit.

## SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

This version of Statements requires MySQL Configurator 8.10.0.3 (or later) in order to enable all functionality. It is **not backward compatible** with versions prior to 7.0.0.10 when control-ID dependent encryption is used, or versions prior to 7.0.0.0 if Changeable Encryption or Multi-Document Storage is used. In order to enable the Multi-Document Storage and Changeable Encryption compatibilities throughout eDOC applications, it is recommended that all eDOC applications be upgraded to 7.9.0.0 or later versions at the same time.

eDOC Innovations officially supports:

- Windows OS 8.1 and Windows 10
- Windows Server 2012, 2016, and 2019 Standard R2
- Internet Explorer 11.x, Chrome 46.0.2490.86 and Firefox 42.0
